### The Life Enrichment Center Leesburg, Florida

The Life Enrichment Center is an adult conference/retreat center operated by the Florida Conference of the United Methodist Church. Housing is provided in motel-type buildings with each room having two twin beds, wall to wall carpeting, air conditioning and private bath. Adjoining rooms are available for family groups.
