#### INTRODUCTION

This <u>Directory</u> is the product of a unique collaborative effort. In October 1986 representatives from ten organizations -- five national nonprofits, one for-profit, three government agencies, and one university program -- met to discuss their mutual interest in their collections of materials on volunteerism. Each participating organization had developed and continued to maintain a major resource center already recognized by researchers of voluntary action.

All ten organizations agreed immediately to two important goals:

- 1) To identify existing collections of materials on volunteerism and to disseminate information about these collections to practitioners, scholars, the media, and other researchers.
- 2) To explore the possibility of building a network among these collections to share information, agree on taxonomy, exchange lists of holdings, and develop compatible computer and manual indexes.

Further, the group committed itself to the primary task of conducting a survey of North American organizations with the objective of compiling at the least a list and at the best a directory of existing library collections. Two years later, this primary task has been accomplished and we are delighted to introduce this Directory to you.

Calling ourselves the "Working Group on Special Collections in Volunteerism," we have conducted our work in true collaborative fashion. We never elected "officers." We planned our activities together and each participating organization committed to -- and completed -- specific tasks within the determined timeframe. We are:

We have enjoyed our collaboration and are presently discussing the possibility of continuing our work and building on this first project. In the meantime, we hope that this <u>Directory</u> will be of genuine usefulness to everyone studying the growing field of volunteerism.

#### METHODOLOGY

In the winter of 1987-88, the Working Group on Special Collections in Volunteerism developed a mailing list of approximately 850 organizations that we speculated would have a collection of materials on volunteerism and sent them a preliminary survey form to determine what resources existed. This mailing list was compiled from the in-house lists of each participating Working Group member plus additional organizations identified during a lengthy planning meeting. We were aware from the start that we would inadvertently overlook some groups, but we felt that our combined spheres of influence gave us at least a wide range of possible contacts.

A total of 327 organizations responded to this first survey, of which 229 indicated that they did have a collection of materials and would be willing to complete a more detailed follow-up questionnaire.

In the spring of 1988, all 229 organizations were sent the detailed questionnaire. Approximately 50 additional organizations were also sent this longer form because the Working Group had reason to believe they in fact had special collections despite not having responded to the first mailing.

With enormous gratitude for the hard work of Barbara Owen, the Working Group compiled the data received from the second questionnaire. This Directory is the result.

In the following pages you will find detailed entries for 102 collections, organized by state or province. These collections met our criteria for inclusion:

- -- Self-identifying a collection of books and/or other materials on the subject of volunteerism, having at least 25 books or 100 "other" items.
- -- Permitting this collection to be accessed by members of the public.

We wanted to include collections in as many states and provinces as possible. Therefore, smaller collections may be shown for states/provinces with no other identified resources, while some collections in geographic regions with many resources may have been placed in the Appendix.

The Appendix contains the names and addresses of an additional 52 collections that did not meet the two criteria above but wished to be listed for the benefit of researchers. These smaller resources are therefore starting points for further study.

Because this is the first attempt ever to identify and report on collections in volunteerism, the Working Group recognizes the limitations of its study:

- -- Because of the methodology of our survey, some collections may have been omitted simply because they were not found.
- -- All information is presented as reported by the responding organization. We relied on each respondent to read our definition of "volunteerism" and apply it to each particular collection. We did no further assessment of the data provided.
- -- Details described in each listing may change over time...including the availability of any collection.

Readers will note that we use the word "collection" rather than the word "library." This is because many of the responding organizations do not perceive themselves as operating a library in the formal sense. They collect and maintain books, periodicals, and other items primarily for their in-house use. While all listed collections are available to the public in some way, most are not managed by professional librarians.

Finally, it is important that all users of this <u>Directory</u> know the definition of "volunteerism" developed by the Working Group to help survey respondents determine whether or not their collections should be included:

**Volunteerism** is all aspects of volunteers and volunteering regardless of setting, or the people doing the activities, or the type of activity performed.

#### ARRANGEMENT OF ENTRIES

The major section of this <u>Directory</u> profiles select public, university, government and special libraries, and nonprofit organizations and agencies in the United States, Canada and England that have indicated they maintain a collection of materials on volunteerism.

Entries are arranged alphabetically by state or province and then by city. Canadian and British organizations follow those for the United States.

ORGANIZATION NAME: Name as supplied by the organization.

ADDRESS: Permanent mailing address.

CONTACT PERSON: Name and Title (if available) of person(s) in charge of the library or resource center.

PHONE NUMBER: Area code and telephone number. Telephone extensions are not provided, as they are subject to frequent changes.

LARGEST AREA SERVED: Largest geographic area served. Survey respondents were asked to choose from among City/Town; County; State/Province; Region or Nation. A more specific area is noted if provided by the organization.

WHO HAS ACCESS?: The specific publics served. Respondents were asked to choose from Staff, Members, Public, or Other.

HOW ARE MATERIALS ACCESSED?: Methods available to acquire materials. Respondents were asked to indicate all that apply from By Phone, In Person, By Mail, By Computer (includes electronic mail), or Other.

POSSIBLE FEES: Indicates that the organization may charge for copying, interlibrary loan services or for publications.

HOLDINGS RELATED TO VOLUNTEERISM: Quantitative data. Respondents were asked to provide separate figures for Books, Periodical Subscriptions, Clippings (including articles and program materials), Audio Visual Materials and Other categories. Estimates of the number of items have frequently been given. The number given for periodical subscriptions generally refers to the number of titles received, rather than the number of separate issues on file.

KEY SUBJECTS COVERED: Respondents were asked to indicate those topics on which they have a specific quantity of materials. <u>Directory</u> entries have been prepared from this original listing:

SPECIAL FOCUS: Special strengths or notable subjects of the collection.

CLASSIFICATION SCHEME USED: Respondents were asked to choose one from among Library of Congress, Dewey Decimal, Old NICOV/NCVA or Other. The phrase "key subject categories" is used for those many respondents who indicated "subject areas" or "categorical" under the Other category.

FORMS OF CATALOGS MAINTAINED: Respondents were asked to choose all applicable forms among Card Catalog, Book/Binder Catalog, Computer Database, Microfilm/Microfiche or Other. For the sake of this <u>Directory</u>, Microfilm/Microfiche appears as Microform.

COMPUTER HARDWARE/SOFTWARE USED: In cases where holdings information is computerized, respondents were asked to indicate the type of mainframe, mini or personal computer and software packages in use.

HOLDINGS LISTS AVAILABLE: Lists of titles on file available either free of charge or for a fee. Respondents were asked to choose all applicable from among Author/Title; Shelf; Subject, or Accession/Acquisition lists.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS PRODUCED: Respondents were asked to choose all applicable from among Annotated Bibliographies, Non-Annotated Bibliographies; Fact Sheets, Monographs, Reports, Books, Newsletters, or Other. The term "Bibliographies" appears for those organizations that produce both annotated and non-annotated bibliographies. SERVICES AVAILABLE: Indicates whether the organization provides Telephone Reference, Interlibrary Loan services, Database Searches, Loans to Individuals and Organizations, or Other services. Services identified in answer to other survey questions are also noted.
